The accompanying list of the Tortrices of Hampshire numbers 154 of the 300 found on the British List.

The Tortrices, though small, are a very interesting family, and will well repay any time expended on them.

In only a few cases localities are given, as it would be impossible in the space to give them all. The month of emergence and the food plant will be a sufficient guide in most cases to the capture of the insect.

The Nomenclature followed is that of Mr. Stainton, to whose book reference has again been made.

Owing to the difficulty of obtaining accurate information (so many collectors entirely neglecting this genus) it is quite possible that some omissions have been made. It is hoped, however, at some future time to issue a supplement, when any additions to this genus, as well as to those that have gone before, may be made.

The compiler begs to offer his sincere thanks to those gentlemen who have kindly given him information.
