ANNUAL REPORT FOR 1927

(Presented to the Annual Meeting held on April 25th, 1928.)

On the date of the last Annual Meeting (April 27th, 1927) the total membership of the Club was 364. It is now 392, and the Society is approaching the maximum number of members, which is fixed at 400.

During the past year the Society has lost by death the Rev. C. H. Conybeare, M.A., a former local secretary for the Alresford district; the Rev. G. Sampson, M.A.; Lieut.-Colonel Holt Stilwell, local secretary for Winchfield and a contributor to the "*Proceedings*"; Mr. James Goggs; and Mr. Charles Cooksey, a keen antiquary of the older school, who was a member for many years and a contributor to the "*Proceedings*."

The thanks of the Club are due to Mr. and Mrs. C. F. Fox, who kindly entertained the Members to tea on June 22nd.

Mr. E. S. McEuen has been appointed as Local Secretary for the Havant district. There are now several districts where Local Secretaries would be welcomed.

In accordance with the resolution passed at the last Annual Meeting the Research Committee of the Club co-operated with the Old Wykehamist excavators (Messrs. J. N. L. Myres, C. F. C. Hawkes and C. G. Stevens) on St. Catherine's Hill, Winchester. The work of 1925 and 1926 on the site of St. Catherine's Chapel was renewed in August: the exact site of the West end was recovered, fixing the length of the building as 145 feet, with a breadth of 90 feet across the transepts. Excavation of the chancel revealed a separate chapel earlier than the 12th Century date of the remainder of the building; by the removal of the western wall, this older chapel had been made to serve as the east end of the larger 12th Century Chapel. The date of this older chapel has not yet been determined.

With the object of dating the earthwork which crowns the hill, a section was taken across the ditch and bank, near the original entrance on the eastern side. The entrance itself was carefully explored and the remains of two rectangular guardhouses, strongly revetted with oak posts and beams, were uncovered. The defence works were proved to have been destroyed by an intense fire, by which the thick linings of clay were reduced to bright red dust. Pottery fragments from the original ground level were of the Early Iron Age, and of a date before the invasion of the Belgae, from whom the valley settlement, afterwards occupied by the Romans, derived its name of Venta Belgarum.

Finds of pottery from dwelling pits within the circle of the earthwork were also of the Early Iron Age and the types were similar to those found at All Cannings Cross and in the early period at Hengistbury Head.

With the concurrence of the Editor it is suggested that an entire number of the Club's "*Proceedings*" should be devoted to reports of the work on St. Catherine's Hill and to Early Iron Age earthworks.
