ANNUAL REPORT FOR 1928

(Presented to the Annual Meeting held on
May 7th, 1929)

On the date of the last Annual Meeting (April 25th, 1928), the total membership of the Club was 399. In view of a maximum membership of 400, special attention was paid to Rule 18 by the Hon. Treasurer and Council. Without decreasing the active membership, the numbers are now 375, and room has been made for keen, new members seeking entry to the Club.

During the past year the Society has lost by death two of its Past Presidents, both distinguished Hampshire noblemen and eminent in public life. The Earl of Northbrook was President 1910-12, and Lord Montagu of Beaulieu twice held the office, in 1912-14 and 1920-22. Others who have passed on include: Mrs. Dukinfield Scott, wife of our Past President, the Rev. E. S. Prideaux-Brune, M.A., the Rev. C. T. Wickham, M.A., Colonel Farquhar, Major G. C. Alletson, D.S.O., Mr. J. H. Blizard, C.E., Mr. A. W. Pearce, J.P., and Mr. J. E. Watson.

During 1928 nine Field Meetings of the Club were held, including two botanical meetings.

Mr. W. J. Lucas, B.A., F.E.S., has been appointed as Subject-Secretary for Entomology, and Colonel Karslake, M.A., F.S.A., has accepted the office of Local Secretary for Silchester and District.

Dr. J. P. Williams Freeman has been appointed to represent the Club on the Hampshire Rural Community Council.

During the year the Club's representative on the New Forest Association, Mr. Heywood Sumner, F.S.A., resigned his position in the Association. After a careful consideration of the reasons which led to that step and the present attitude of the Association to Crown management and Forestry in the New Forest, your Council recommend that the vacant position be not filled at present.

Mr. W. E. Troke, who has shown a keen interest in all architectural matters in the Southampton district, drew the attention of the Club to the present neglected condition of the old church at Millbrook. A report was drawn up by the local Secretaries for Southampton, Mr. H. Glasspool and Dr. Alexander Evans, and was laid before the Council of the Club. It was decided that the Club should support the Society for the Protection of Ancient Buildings in its efforts to safeguard the interesting portions of the building.

In August the excavations on St. Catharine's Hill, Winchester, conducted by Messrs. J. N. L. Myres, C. F. C. Hawkes and C. G. Stevens, were continued for the fourth season and completed. The Early Iron Age Settlement inside the rampart was carefully investigated and twelve dwelling pits were uncovered; the pottery and other objects found belonged to the later Hallstatt and the La Tène I and II periods. The earthworks seem to have been made at a late stage of the occupation and to date from not earlier than the middle of the 4th century B.C. Further careful investigation was made of the main entrance with its problems of successive occupation and reconstruction. The final sack and burning seem to have been as early as 250 B.C., a period earlier than the Belgic invasion.

It is proposed that the full results of the excavations of the Iron Age Settlement, the ramparts and St. Catharine's Chapel, should be published as a special number of the Club's *Proceedings*.

It is gratifying to record that the work of the Hamble River Preservation Committee has been successful. Arrangements have been made to purchase land on the left bank of the Hamble River and on both sides of Curbridge Creek, so that the beauty of these river banks will be preserved.

ANNUAL REPORT FOR 1929

(Presented to the Annual Meeting held on
April 30th, 1930)

During the past year the membership of the Club and the active interest of the members has been maintained. Beginning with 375 members, the number is now 379.

The Society has lost by the hand of death one of its Past Presidents, Mr. C. E. Keyser, M.A., F.S.A., D.L., who was President 1916-18; Mr. Richard Bell, V.D., an active member of the Club's Council, and one of the Local Secretaries for the New Forest; the Rev. A. R. Miles, M.A., also well versed in New Forest lore; Mr. James Druitt of Bournemouth, a member of a family keenly interested in archaeology and kindred subjects; Mr. W. C. H. Burne of St. Mary Bourne, a contributor to our *Proceedings*, and the Rev. R. F. Bigg-Wither, M.A., a former Vice-President.

During 1929, nine Field Meetings of the Club were held, including two botanical meetings. Thanks to the favourable weather, the attendances were large, and the number of visitors was greater than ever before.

Mr. F. W. Anderson, M.Sc., of University College, Southampton, has been appointed as Geological Subject Secretary for Hampshire, and Mr. Patrick M. Hall has consented to work with Mr. J. F. Rayner as Subject Secretary for Botany.

Dr. J. P. Williams Freeman has been appointed as the representative of the Club on the newly-formed Hampshire Branch of the Society for the Preservation of Rural England.

Volume XI of the Society's *Proceedings*, dealing with the St. Catharine's Hill, Winchester, excavations, has been issued to members whose subscriptions were paid for 1929. The volume deals with the excavations of the prehistoric earthwork and the pit dwellings enclosed thereby, and also with the four seasons' work (1925—1928) on the site of the mediæval Chapel.

INDEX OF ARCHITECTURAL RECORDS.

A Committee representing the Royal Archaeological Society, the Royal Institute of British Architects, the London Society, and the Society for the Protection of Ancient Buildings has been formed to explore the possibility of compiling a central card index of prints, drawings and other architectural records. It is felt that this should be of great assistance to those engaged upon the repair of old buildings, to writers of architectural, archaeological or topographical works and to students generally.

If it should meet with success, it is not unlikely that it would be developed to include some means of storing such records in a central and safe place, should they be loaned, offered or bequeathed.

It is proposed to limit the scope of the Committee's work to buildings at least a century old and to those of England only, but it is hoped that parallel action will be undertaken in Scotland and Wales.

It is realised that an immense amount of such records are in private hands, and it would be useful to the Committee if owners would give particulars of their collections now, for with this knowledge the Committee will be better able to form an idea of the extent and scope of the enterprise.
