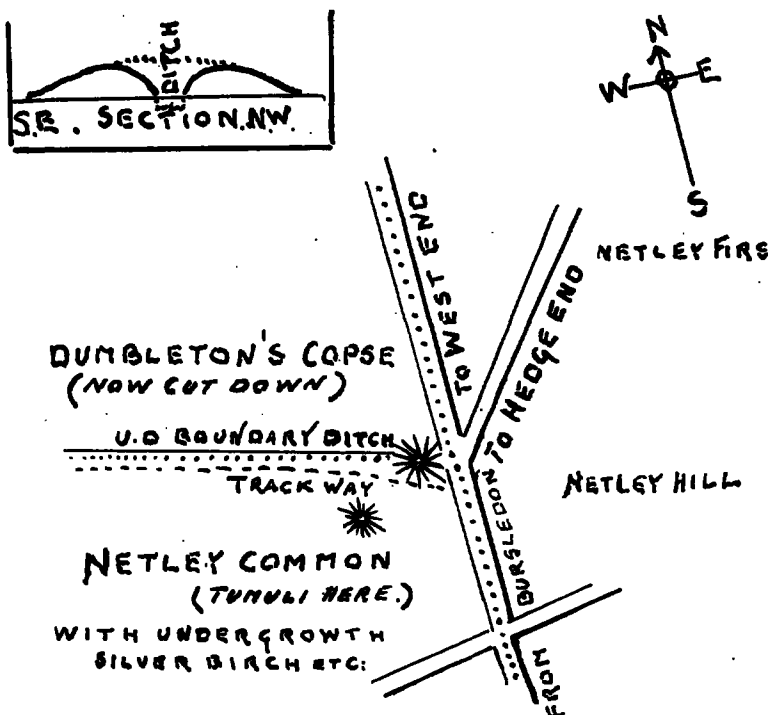


TUMULI ON NETLEY HILL, BURSLEDON

FUTURE students interested in pre-historic Hampshire will look in vain for the tumuli on Netley Hill, Bursledon, marked on the Ordnance Survey 6in. Map LXVI S.W. and shewn in the above plan.

In addition to these two I was able to locate two more during a period of the clearance of underwood some few years ago, although then nearly obliterated, and to-day quite lost in the thick growth of intervening years. It is of the largest of the two tumuli, that on the edge of the Bursledon to West End highway
