The editors regret that through lack of suitable copy this volume contains neither contributions in the fields of natural history and industrial archaeology, nor, despite the large amount of recent work in Hampshire, a major report of archaeological excavations.

The editors hope to publish *Proceedings*, Vol. 33, for 1976, in April 1977, and to include among its contents a report on the Roman villa at Twyford and the first of a series of reports on excavations along the line of the M3 motorway.
